2011 RIESLING

We have produced this Riesling for eight years and each vintage seems to bring its own, distinct character. In 2011 we sourced this Riesling from an exciting new vineyard: Hobbit Hollow, on the west side of Lake Canandaigua, in the Finger Lakes of New York. As always, we leave our Rieslings in tank or bottle for almost a year before release. Slightly off-dry.
